### Running terminal

# You run the terminal through $(Applications) \rightarrow (System Tools) \rightarrow (Terminal)$

- You can also run the terminal by clicking the display-icon at the top of your screen.
- You can enter UNIX commands on the terminal.

### Running Firefox on the terminal

\$ firefox & [Enter key]

- Type "&" at the end of the command. Otherwise, you cannot use the terminal when Firefox ends.
- Quit Firefox by clicking the "×" button at the upper right of the window.
